Resolution

Pursuant to Art. 84 Sect. 5 of Act No.131/2002 of the Coll. on Higher Education and on the changing and amending some acts (hereinafter referred to as "Act"), after statement by the Accreditation Commission of the Government of the Slovak Republic

I recognize

The Slovak Medical University in Bratislava

the right to grant

relevant academic degrees to graduates of

study programmes

in the study fields

listed in the Annex to this resolution forming its integral part.

The right is granted by the basis of statements of the Accreditation Commission to requests that were submitted by the high school in the complex accreditation actions of high school. This right is granted in the extent and form specified in individual study programmes. In justified cases the right is granted with time restrictions. It is necessary to proceed by the Act. Pursuant to Art. 3 Sect. 10 of Act No.104/2003 of the Coll. according to Government of the Slovak Republic by the Accreditation Commission on the wording of certain provisions, the University is obligated to notify in writing up to ten days to the Accreditation Commission the change in case of individual study programmes guaranteed.

No appeal can be made against this resolution.
