

## UPDATE

of the binding guideline of the Faculty of Medicine of the SMU for teaching in the winter semester 2020/2021 for the study program General Medicine of non-ending years  
**valid from 10<sup>th</sup> November 2020**

### **NON-STATE YEARS: study program General Medicine**

All lectures and theoretical seminars and practical exercises will be conducted in a distance form in the time schedule of the valid for the winter semester 2020/2021. The distance form of education will be performed online via the TEAMS application (directly or recorded with voice commentary; instructions published on the SMU Website), or another suitable and available application.

**Clinical internships will take place until further notice in the form of clinical seminars** according to the originally planned time schedule in a modified form (focus on case studies, or virtual patient), while no teaching at the patient's bedside. **These seminars will take place only in a distance form** via the TEAMS application (instructions published on the SMU website), or another suitable and available application. The content and form of these seminars will be decided by the heads of pedagogical departments, who are also responsible for the organization and logistics of these seminars.

***In the case of subjects where the mentioned clinical internships (clinical seminars) cannot be performed even in a distance form, the heads of pedagogical departments (subject guarantors) will notify the students that these clinical internships (or seminars) are canceled until further notice. Students will use the time for intensive self-study of theory with the possibility of consultations (provided by the head of pedagogical departments).***

Teaching in **FINAL STATE YEAR** takes place according to the original guidelines from 4<sup>th</sup> November 2020 **(no change!)**

**The instructions will be continuously updated according to the current situation.**
