

**Binding guideline of the Faculty of Medicine of the Slovak Medical University
in Bratislava for the examination period in the winter semester 2020/2021 for
the study programme General Medicine
valid from 21st December 2020**

In consideration of the current epidemiological development, the Management of the Faculty of Medicine of the SMU regulates the examination period as follows:

NON-STATE YEARS (1st -5th year): General Medicine

Exams will be performed in the *distance form in the form of an oral answer and / or a test.

Pre-terms examination: 21st December 2020 – 31st December 2020 (without change)
Dates will be published through the MAIS by 17th December 2020.

EXAMINATION PERIOD: 4th January 2021 – 5th February 2021 (without change)
Dates will be published through the MAIS by 23rd December 2020.

STATE YEARS (6th year): General Medicine

DATES OF THE FINAL STATE EXAMS: according to the valid schedule (without change)

The Final State exams will be running in person, in compliance of all anti-epidemic measurements to ensure the smooth running of the winter semester of the academic year 2020/2021 listed on the SMU website (the participant must not have symptoms of infectious and respiratory disease, must not be in quarantine, must have a facial mask, disinfect hands before entering the room, the room must be ventilated, the number of people in the room will be limited). **Participants who will take exams in person must show a proof of the negative result of the RT-PCR test or the relevant antigen test not older than 7 days.** Examination in a *distance form can be approached strictly individually after the decision of the responsible head of the pedagogical department only for students who are in obligatory quarantine at the time of the examination.

*** CONDITIONS FOR THE DISTANCE FORM EXAMS:**

For the distance form of the examination, it is necessary that each student has a functional smartphone or laptop with a functional camera (with a sufficient source of energy) and a room in where will be alone and not disturbed by anyone. This will be proved by the capture a camera, which will be located to capture it throughout the exam, so that it can be show that participant is alone in the room throughout the exam and has no way to search for information in any way. The student also proves himself/ herself with an ID card or a student ID card. Students, one by one will choose questions and answer them immediately, without written preparation. The head of the pedagogical department is responsible for the logistics.
